

MDT Meeting
or
Component Consultation

MDT (Multidisciplinary Team) meetings are a gathering of professionals who have special expertise in their specific fields. These professionals may include, but are not limited to:

- Mental Health Coordinator
- Nutrition Services Supervisor
- Registered Nurse
- Disabilities Services Supervisor
- Health Services Coordinator
- Disabilities Resource Assistant

The MDT meetings are available to all Supervisors, TFA/FA, CFA/CFE, Teachers, and/or parents regardless of the center the child attends.

When there are concerns in more than one area (nutrition, disabilities, mental health, health), an MDT meeting should be requested on a D-01 Referral form. After receiving the D-01, the Disabilities Resource Assistant will contact staff to make meeting arrangements and inform Resource Team members.

Component Consultation

If there is a concern in one area (nutrition, disabilities, mental health, or health), a consultation should be requested on the D-01 Referral form. After logging the referral, the Disabilities Resource Assistant will forward the request to the Resource Team member responsible for that area. Staff will be contacted by the Resource Team member to make needed arrangements.

Both MDT meetings and Component Consultations can be scheduled on an as-needed basis. They can also be scheduled at Admin or at your site.
